These grants may be used to purchase: materials, supplies and/or pay stipends for before or after school initiatives (district stipend guidelines must be followed when paying staff members: certified/classified). In addition, these grants should include an on-site coordinator to facilitate arrival and dismissal of students as well as student safety. Extended learning grants are awarded for classroom grants up to \$1,000 and building-level grants up to \$5,000.
